

Russia to Provide Egypt With Air Defense Missiles

The head of Russia's state-controlled industrial holding company says Moscow has signed a deal to provide Egypt with air defense missile systems.

Monday's statement by Russian Technologies chief Sergei Chemezov followed last week's trip to Egypt by Russia's foreign and defense ministries.

Chemezov did not elaborate on the missile deal in his comments carried by RIA Novosti.

He said that Egypt also expressed interest in other Russian weapons, including combat planes and helicopters, but has funding problems. He said Egypt could ask Russian for a loan to finance the weapons deals.

The deal comes as U.S.-Egyptian relations have been strained over Washington's criticism of the July 3 military coup.

The Soviet Union armed Egypt for decades at the height of the Cold War and Egypt's wars with Israel.
