

Investigative Website Bellingcat Seeks Funding for Russian Version

The British citizen journalist and blogger Eliot Higgins started Bellingcat for citizen

journalists to launch investigations using open-source information.

The website was launched on July 15, 2014 after a successful Kickstarter funding campaign, with Higgins and eight volunteers providing content, Newsweek reported in June 2015.

Bellingcat investigated the downing of [Malaysia Airlines Flight 17](#) in Ukraine using open-source information.
