Russian President Vladimir Putin showed off his growing Middle East clout on Monday with his first visit to Saudi Arabia in over a decade.

During the welcoming ceremony at the royal palace in Riyadh, musicians made Putin and Saudi King Salman stand for an ear-piercing rendition of the Russian national anthem.
